The Scholarship Committee of Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church invites you to apply for one of the eleven scholarships that will be awarded in **June of this year.** The scholarships are awarded based upon a minimum grade point average, church/school/club participation, and economic need, essay on what the church means to you, and the application typed and neatly completed.

If you have a cumulative grade point average of **3.5 or above** and meet the other criteria, you are automatically applying for the **"Super"** scholarship. In order to receive one of these scholarships, you must be enrolled or have plans to enroll in a college or vocational school.

- 2. Please submit a **current transcript along with application on or before** <u>May 18,</u> <u>2025,</u> to verify your cumulative grade point average. <u>This must be submitted by your School Counselor</u> to verify each applicant's cumulative grade point average, along with application.
- 3. Applications must be returned by *Sunday*, <u>May 18, 2025</u>, to the Scholarship Mailbox in a sealed envelope, via email <u>iljones@shilohmbc.com</u>, or <u>jwilliams@shilohmbc.com</u> no later than 11:59am, or mail to: 185 Eddie Robinson Sr. Dr., Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70802. NO EXCEPTIONS!

SHILOH MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM – 2025

I. **OVERVIEW**

The Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church, pastored by the Reverend Charles T. Smith, implemented a scholarship program for its members in 1975. A scholarship committee appointed by the pastor administers the program. Originally, thirty-five thousand dollars were divided into *eleven scholarships*. Money was issued per semester upon verification of continued enrollment in school.

II. **DUTIES OF COMMITTEE**

- A. To set up guidelines governing the scholarship program.
- B. To design instruments for evaluating applicants in an objective manner.
- C. To periodically evaluate the scholarship program.
- D. Letters are sent to church ministry and auxiliary leaders requesting information on each applicant via email.
- E. After all the information is received, the committee meets to determine the recipients of the scholarships.
- F. To annually select the top eleven applicants based on a set of objective criteria.
- G. To annually publicize the scholarship program.

III. FINANCING OF PROGRAM

Money is generated jointly from Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church and Shiloh's Charitable Foundation.

IV. AMOUNTS OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Beginning in 2004, Fifty Thousand Dollars will be divided into maximum scholarships as follows: Super Scholarship - \$8,000; 1st place - \$5,050; 2nd place - \$4,900; 3rd place - \$4,700; 4th place - \$4,500; 5th place - \$4,300; 6th place - \$4,100; 7th place - \$3,900; 8th place - \$3,700; 9th place - \$3,500; 10th place - \$3,350. If there are not a sufficient number of applicants, there will be no carryover of funds.

V. REQUIREMENTS OF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS All Applicants Must Meet All Requirements.

- A. <u>Must</u> be a member of Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church for at least <u>two years</u> & completed High School for the last **2** years in **Louisiana**.
- B. Must be a high school graduate in Louisiana.

- C. Must be enrolled or have plans of enrolling in a university, community college or technical school.
- D. Must use funds for undergraduate studies. If there are unclaimed funds after the recipient graduates, unused funds may be applied to graduate studies within one year after graduation.
- E. Must have a grade point average of at least **2.5.**
- F. Must have participated in church/school/community activities, ministries, Zoom Sunday school/Bible Study, etc., within the *last 2 years*. The Superintendent of the Sunday school, Bible Study *Teacher must verify all attendance*.
- G. The overall church/school community participation, essay and teacher/school principal must be a minimum of 30 points.
- H. If an applicant is attending a college out-of-town and has 30% Sunday school/Bible study attendance, his/her application will be considered.
- I. If a ministry/auxiliary has only been in existence for six (6) months or less, It will not be considered for that year.
- J. A member of the Shiloh Scholarship Committee may apply for a scholarship; however, he/she may not participate in the evaluation process.

VI. **PROCEDURE/POLICY**

- A. The committee evaluates each applicant based on a set of criteria previously adopted by the committee. The criteria are attached.
- B. Other than grade point averages, the information reported on the application is classified as being true. Designated points are given for Educational Background, Church/School/Club Participation, Economic Need, Personal Statements and Neatly Submitted Applications (See Evaluation form).
- C. After points are totaled for each applicant, the applicant's name and his/her total points are listed. No committee member can determine the recipients until all applicants' points have been totaled.
- D. The names of the scholarship recipients are withheld until the Sunday that the scholarships are awarded.
- E. No recipient of a regular scholarship may apply for the Charles & Winstonia McKesson Smith Memorial Scholarship until he/she becomes a college senior or graduate student.

- F. Students may only apply for one (1) scholarship per year.
- G. Recipients of a scholarship must **enroll** and **remain** in a school of higher learning for the entire quarter/semester. If a recipient drops out of school, funds will be forfeited. If there are mitigating circumstances due to personal health issues that a recipient has no control over, the scholarship award will be reinstated upon verification from a physician.
- **H.** The value of the awarded scholarship will be prorated to pay the cost of tuition plus an additional \$600 for books; the remaining amount will be awarded on a semester basis until funds are depleted. A billing statement from the school must be submitted. Scholarships will be awarded only at the beginning of the summer, fall, or spring semester/quarter. The recipients of the scholarships may collect the scholarships once verification is submitted that he/she is accepted in school. If awarded you have 3 years to claim the award.
- I. Applications must be returned by the deadline date.

VII. THE SUPER SCHOLARSHIP

In 2004, the face value of this scholarship increased to \$8,000. Three thousand dollars will be given in the first semester, two thousand dollars in the second and one thousand five hundred dollars will be given in the third and fourth semesters. Money will be issued per semester upon verification of continued enrollment in school.

VIII. CRITERIA FOR THE "SUPER" SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient must:

- 1. Be a member of Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church for at least one year and must have completed High School in *2 years in Louisiana*.
- 2. Have a **3.5** or above cumulative GPA.
- 3. Have participated in church/school/club activities, ministries, Zoom Bible study/Sunday School, etc., within the current or previous year.
- 4. Be a graduate of the current school year.
- 5. The Super Scholarship Recipient is *not eligible to apply* for the Charles & Winstonia McKesson Smith Memorial Scholarship.
- 6. The overall church/school/club participation, and essay.

X. PROCEDURE FOR BREAKING TIES

In case of a tie, the person with the highest-grade point average will be the recipient. If the grade point average are the same, the person who is more actively involved in Church work will be ranked higher and/or the recipient will be given <u>an</u> <u>interview</u>.
